Blue Ridge School is an all-boys, college preparatory, boarding school in the USA founded in 1909. We are experts in how boys learn best.

Currently there are 182 boys enrolled representing 21 states, the District of Columbia and 24 foreign countries. Approximately 30 percent of the students come from traditionally under-represented ethnic groups. The student/faculty ratio is less than 6/1 with an average class size of eight.

Our curriculum is always undergoing revisions in an effort to offer our students the best possible options to ensure their preparedness for and success in college. We intentionally design classes and schedules to meet the needs of boys so not every class is offered yearly. We do offer dual enrollment in courses for college credit with Piedmont Virginia Community College. Dual enrollment courses are available in Pre-calculus, Calculus, Calculus II and World History.

BRS is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, Virginia Association of Independent Schools, and a member of the National Association of Independent Schools, the Secondary School Admission Testing Board, the Council for the Advancement of Schools and Education, The Association of Boarding Schools, the Potomac Association for College Admissions Counseling, and the National Association for College Admissions Counseling.
