

Blue Ridge School is an all-boys, college preparatory, boarding school in the USA founded in 1909. We prepare our students to thrive in college and to be men of character.

Currently there are 156 boys enrolled representing 21 states, the District of Columbia, and 12 foreign countries. Approximately 31 percent of the students come from traditionally under-represented ethnic groups. The student/faculty ratio is less than 6/1 with an average class size of eight.

Our curriculum undergoes constant revision in order to offer students options that will prepare them for success in college. We intentionally design classes and schedules to meet the needs of boys.

BRS is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools and by the Virginia Association of Independent Schools, and is a member of the National Association of Independent Schools, the Secondary School Admission Testing Board, the Council for the Advancement of Schools and Education, The Association of Boarding Schools, the Potomac Association for College Admissions Counseling, and the National Association for College Admissions Counseling.
